T _ _ _ _ _

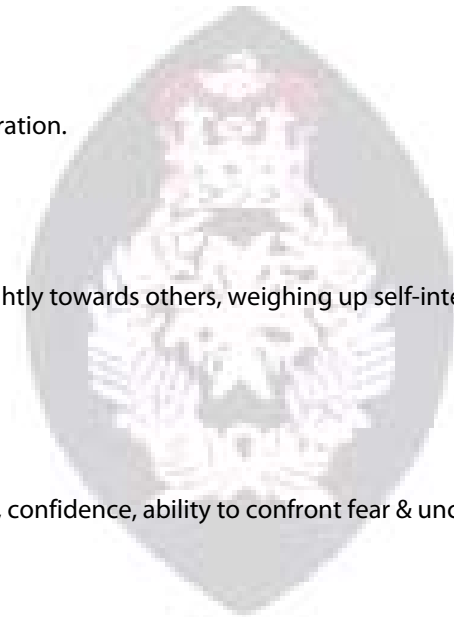
Self-control, moderation.

19. How many years of efficient adult service do you need to obtain to be awarded the St John service medal?

The origins of the white eight pointed cross of St John can be traced back to around 1023 when the merchants of Amalfi restored the hospice in the Holy Land which had previously been established and destroyed.

Raymond Du Puy, the second master of the Order, established the first code of conduct where at the ceremony of admittance of young men as Knights of the Order, they took the vow of the four Cardinal Virtues and the eight Beatitudes stemming from these virtues – all represented in the eight-pointed cross.
